## HOW THIS WORKS:

You commit two years serving a ministry site in Albany Synod. Albany Synod commits:

- Salary, benefits, and housing so that you may serve joyfully at your ministry site.
- Small group coaching, mentoring, and peer group meetings.
- A support team from your congregation who will walk alongside you and learn with you.
- Periodic and guided evaluation for yourself, your ministry site, and mentor.
- An invitation to the Albany Synod annual retreat for early ministry called Beginning and Beyond
- Enrollment in Faithwalking 101, 201, 202, and 301: a process of spiritual formation for missional living.
- Training in Healthy Communications.
- A place to try new ideas, explore new interests, network, learn, retreat, and fail all within a safe, supportive community.
